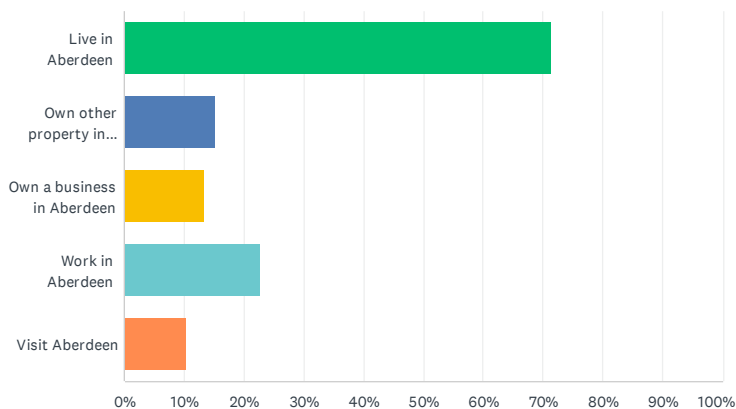

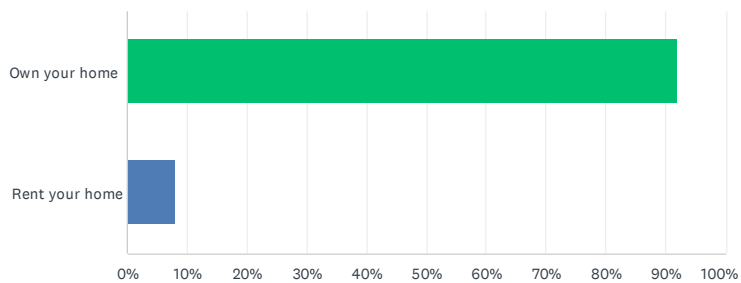

### Q2 If you live in Aberdeen, do you:

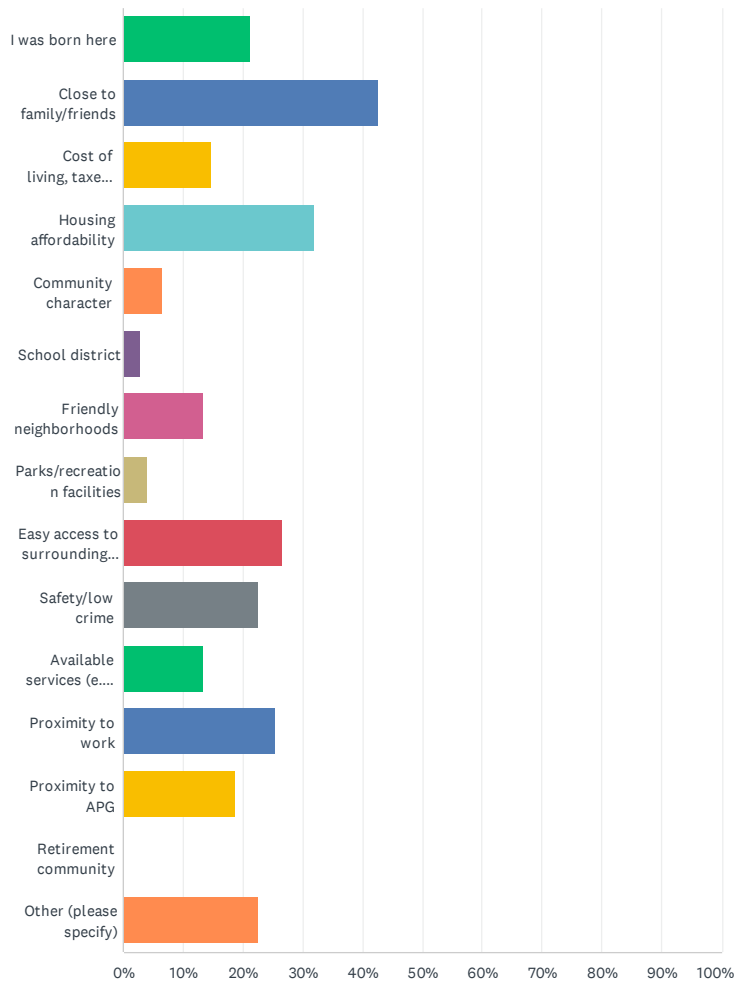

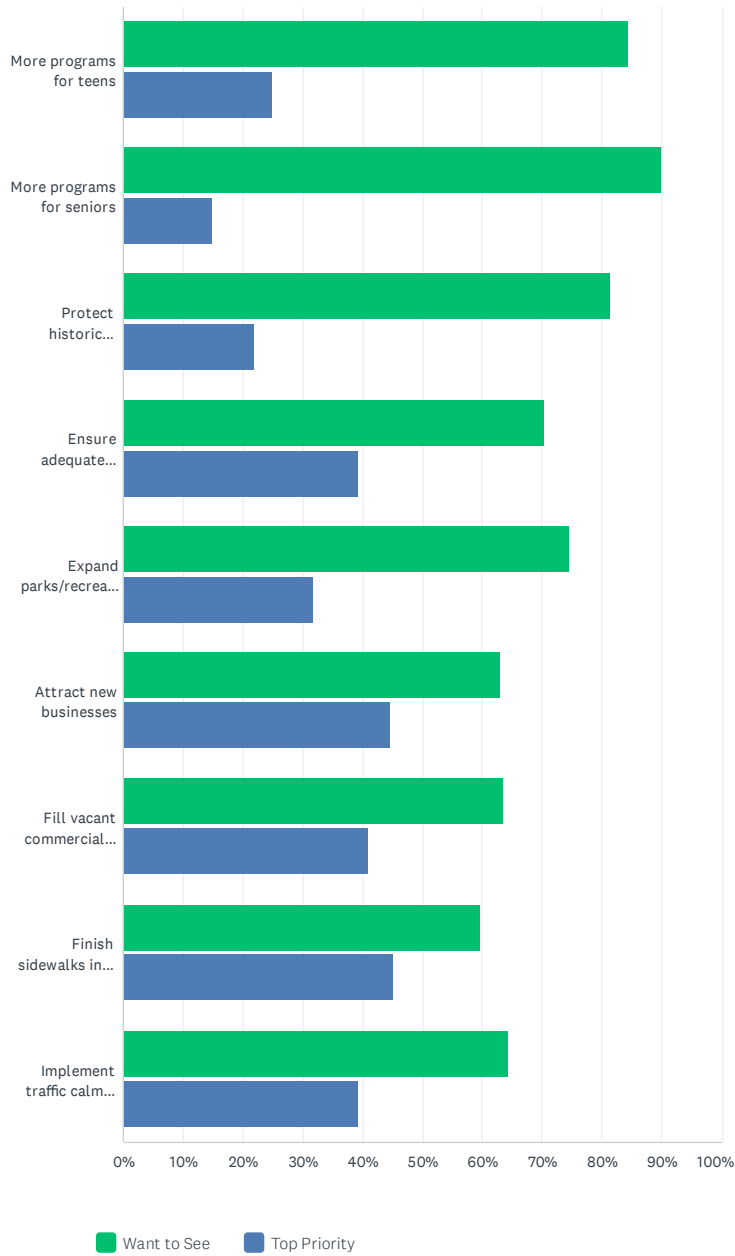
